

What are the academic standards for this program?

Graduate students are expected to be capable academic students. Despite the challenges of graduate-level study, degree- and nondegree-seeking students must maintain a minimum grade point average and passing grades in all courses.

Minimum Grades

B required in all 400/800 level courses used for a degree and in the student's major; B- is not acceptable.

Grade of Pass or C is needed in all 800-900 level courses, in student's major and minor areas of study, used for a Degree. C- is not acceptable.

≥C+ needed for UG/G SpEd methods courses in order to student teach (e.g., SpEd 802, 804, 862, 861, 882)

Grades below C+ can not be used for Certification/Endorsement requirements.

Pass/NoPass (P/NP) Option

Possible for:

- Only 800- and 900-level courses in your major and 400- 800-level courses in the minor area.

- Only 12 cr of UnderGraduate-level courses used for Certification/Endorsement can be P/NP

- Only Graduate-level courses used for a degree

P/NP not possible for UG/G-level methods, or Grad-level courses used for Endorsements
