Note. Students admitted to the program can submit for equivalency evaluation graduate courses and credits earned from master’s degree work at a previous institution. If coursework from the previous institution is judged by the instructor of the UNL course to be equivalent, the requirement can be waived. EDPS 868 (Multicultural Counseling), EDPS 984 (Ethics), and EDPS 975 (Vocational Psychology) are exceptions and must be taken at UNL even if the student had previously taken the course at another institution.

Expected time for completion of the doctoral degree in Counseling Psychology is five years for post-master’s students and six years for post-baccalaureate students including a one-year full-time pre-doctoral internship.
