

MA WITH AN EMPHASIS IN ELEMENTARY TEACHING (MA^{ET})
STATE OF NEBRASKA ACADEMIC COURSEWORK REQUIREMENTS FOR ELEMENTARY ENDORSEMENT

In order to become “endorsed”, or certified, to teach at the elementary level in the State of Nebraska, you must have completed sufficient general academic coursework, typically as part of your undergraduate degree. Complete this form to determine whether you meet general education requirements for certification in the State of Nebraska. This will help you know whether your previous academic coursework is sufficient for certification. The information you provide here must correspond to the information in your transcripts.

Part I. A minimum of 30 semester hours of academic coursework distributed across the four curriculum areas of English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies/history. A minimum of 6 semester hours is required in each of the four areas with a letter grade no lower than a C in any of the courses. Coursework in the four core areas includes:

1. Communication in the English language arts, including English literature, composition, and speech (COMM);
2. Mathematics (must be *college algebra* or above), including statistics and mathematical reasoning (MATH);
3. Natural sciences (NS); and
4. Social sciences (SS).
