Acceptance into the German Teacher Education Program is required before enrollment in the Professional Education courses. 80% of the endorsement courses must be completed prior to enrolling in TEAC 451R. The professional education sequence begins spring semester, continues in the fall semester, and is followed by a semester of student teaching.

## Endorsement Courses (30-46 hrs)

Notes: A minimum of 30 credit hours beyond Intermediate German is required. GERM 101, 102, 201 and 202 may be waived depending upon the Modern Language Placement Exam. In order to student teach, the Nebraska Dept of Education requires that you pass the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Exam & the Writing Proficiency Exam at the Advanced Low level. This generally requires an immersion experience in the target culture for an extended period of time. Without spending time in the target culture it is challenging at best to teach in the language and about the culture of the language you are teaching.
