### **Additional Program Requirements**

Each student will complete a Portfolio, as approved by the adviser. The Portfolio will serve as the written comprehensive examination and will include evidence of research activity.

### **Additional State Requirements**

For Nebraska administrative certification and endorsement, students must also satisfy additional state requirements, including but not limited to, eligibility for a Standard Teaching Certificate, two years teaching experience, Human Relations Training, Special Education Training, and Basic Skills Competency.

### **Additional Administrative Endorsements**

Those seeking PreK-12 endorsement, or endorsement at a different level from their teaching endorsement, must complete a minimum of nine graduate semester credit hours of additional coursework beyond the thirty-six credit hours required for the principal endorsement at the level at which they were prepared to teach. The nine credit hours shall include preparation appropriate for the additional level.
