

## *Academic Skills Clinic*

The *Academic Skills Clinic* teaches parents how to assist their children at home in the areas of reading, math, and writing. Within this clinic, individualized assessments are administered to determine the most appropriate and effective teaching strategy and parents are trained to use this strategy at home. Additionally, progress monitoring strategies are developed and taught to parents to measure each student's academic growth.

This clinic can also assist parents with homework concerns and low levels of student motivation. In addition, therapists can consult with a student's school, if needed.

This clinic operates on Tuesday from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm from September through April.
