## MA WITH AN EMPHASIS IN SECONDARY ENGLISH STATE OF NEBRASKA ACADEMIC COURSEWORK

In order to become certified to teach English at the secondary level (grades 6-12) in the state of Nebraska, you must complete sufficient hours of collegiate English in order to satisfy Rule 24 of the Nebraska Department of Education.

The MAenT requires applicants to have at least 42 hours of English and English-related courses by May (prior to beginning coursework in the program). 36 credits of these English credits must fall within the four content areas identified in Rule 24 of the Nebraska Department of Education:

- Reading
- Composition/Writing
- Language/Linguistics
- Literature (i.e., American, British, African American, Native American, Women's, etc.)

Please record the courses that you have taken in these areas. The information provided here must correspond exactly to the information contained in your transcripts. This will assist MAenT advisors in assessing whether your background will meet the requirements for certification in the state of Nebraska. Please note: There may be one or more topic areas that have not been covered in your courses; however, this should not prevent you from applying.
