Step 1: Read the question carefully.

Step 2: Change the question into part of the answer and write it down.

Step 3: Locate the section of the chapter that talks about the topic. Use the headings and subheadings to help you find the section of the chapter that talks about the topic.

Step 4: Read the section of the chapter until you find the answer.

Step 5: Complete the answer.
