Graduate programs have competitive admissions requirements. Students must satisfy the following requirements to continue progressing through the undergraduate program.

1. Completion of SLPA 150 and 250 by the end of semester 2 with an average GPA of 3.0 or better in these courses.
2. Completion of the following:
 - a. SLPA 251,
 - b. BIOS 213 / 213L or BIOS 214,
 - c. PHYS 141 or CHEM 109
 - d. And a cumulative GPA of 3.0 by semester 5.
3. Completion of SLPA 454, 455, and 456 with an average GPA of 3.0 or better in these courses before moving on to SLPA 496.
