ANTICIPATED PROGRAM COSTS

Textbook and Course Materials Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Average \$500 per semester • Student are responsible for laboratory/course fees, including any equipment or clothing that is required to participate in the UNL Athletic Training Program.
Professional Malpractice Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No cost to student while attending clinical education activities.
Clinical Attire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletic Training Students enrolled in the professional program will be provided several clothing items from the UNL Athletic Medicine Department to be worn as a uniform during clinical education activities at UNL. • Refer to the UNL Athletic Training Student Handbook, Chapter 4, Section 1, Clinical Education Dress Code for specific details regarding appropriate uniforms for clinical education activities. • Name Tags – Two (2) UNL ATP Name Tags will be provided by the program. Additional name tags may be purchased at a cost of \$10.00 each
Immunizations, Health & Dental Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are responsible for the costs associated with obtaining required immunizations. • Students are responsible for obtaining personal Health and Dental Insurance. • Cost of Insurance will vary by student. • Students have the option of purchase health insurance from the university.
First Aid and Professional Rescuer CPR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$80.00 every two (2) years • \$80.00 – Spring Semester of Freshman year • \$80.00 – Spring Semester of Junior year
Travel to off-campus clinical assignments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are responsible for obtaining reliable transportation to and from assigned off-campus clinical sites. The cost of transportation will vary based on the type of transportation, location of the assigned clinical site, and the clinical schedule developed between the student and the assigned clinical preceptor. • Refer to the UNL Athletic Training Student Handbook, Chapter 3, Section 15, Travel for Clinical Education Activities to Events at Away Venues for specific details. • Students assigned to off campus clinical sites are encouraged to car-pool with fellow students when available.
National Athletic Trainers' Association Membership	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$80.00 annually (Recommended – Not Required)
Criminal Background Check (Professional Program Only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approximately \$29.00 including Nebraska tax • Initial Background check covers the first three years of the professional program. • A second background check will need to be completed if a student takes a gap year while enrolled in the UNL ATP.
