In order to become certified to teach foreign at the secondary level (grades 7-12) in the State of Nebraska, you must complete sufficient coursework in the target language. We require MAIta applicants to have earned at least 30 credit hours in the language of study at the 203 level or above with grades of 3.0 [B] or above.

Students must also pass the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview with a score of Advanced Low. Any academic deficiencies must be remedied by the time students enter the program.
