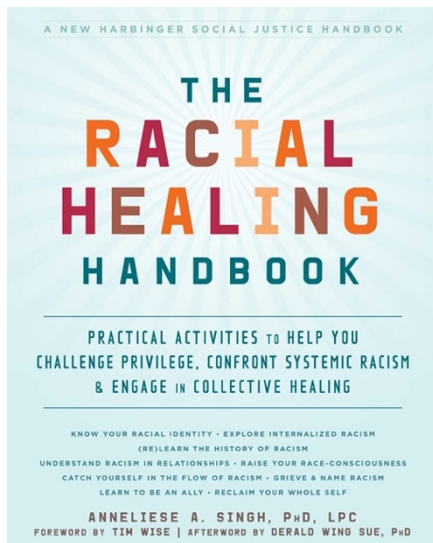
Open to all educators looking to learn, grow, & make a difference
